



Informational Release for Oregon Teens
Low/No Income Subsidy Program
[Oregon Approved Driver Education Programs]

There is now a program through ODOT and Driver Education providers that gives a scholarship to students who are on the free and reduced meals program in their school district.

Even if you don't go to public school, you can qualify for this program if your family has a letter showing you are qualified for free or reduced services.



Who?

- Any teen between 15 and 18 years of age and doesn't have their license yet, is eligible for this subsidy.
- Teens must show an Approved Provider a copy of documentation from their school district or ESD that shows their family qualifies for free or reduced meals.

How?

- An Approved Driver Education Provider grants a \$75 scholarship to a qualifying teen. THEN the provider receives a \$75 subsidy reimbursement from ODOT.



- The provider is responsible to verify the qualifying documentation so don't give 'em a hard time if you don't bring anything with you to document. The Provider shouldn't ask to keep the document; that's your business.
