## RCC announces a nine-month Medical Assistant Certificate

This limited-entry, 9-month certificate program prepares students to function as competent, medical assistants and sit for the NHA, CCMA, CPT and the American Society of Clinical Pathologists ASCP phlebotomy certification exams. MA's work as part of the patient care team with doctors, nurses, and clinic staff to bring excellent quality care to patients.

The number of jobs for Medical Assistants nationwide is expected to increase 35% state-wide, 24% in Jackson and Josephine counties through 2020.<sup>1</sup>
