<sup>3</sup>Accepted students must attach proof of valid unencumbered Oregon CNA license or course completion verification with their application. If submitting a course completion verification, applicant must provide an Oregon CNA license by November 1 to retain acceptance and be admitted to the first practical nursing course the following winter term.

<sup>4</sup>Successful completion of CS120 or equivalent course or passing the RCC computer proficiency exam within the last 10 years fulfills this requirement. Contact a computer science adviser to help determine placement.

<sup>5</sup> WR121 – 3 credits will be accepted.
